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## Tasting Notes

Intense ruby red with violetish tones.

In the nose, it is an intense wine. With notes of black pepper and green pepper, curry blended with subtle hints of toasted bread, provided by the contact with oak.

In the mouth, it's a concentrated and full-bodied wine, with active tannins with long and harmonic finish.

## Vineyard

### "SAN JOSÉ"

Vineyard: 32 acres that were planted in 1975, grown on trellis system.

Height: at 1700 m.a.s.l.

Soil: sandy and stony near the mountain.

Irrigation: Dripping system.

## Harvest

Early in the morning on 2nd April 2017. Carefully and selected hand-picked grapes, using 20 kgs plastic boxes.

## Winemaking

Fermentation using selected yeasts, at controlled temperatures with two daily remontages and one daily delestage. Maceration for a total of three weeks, including alcoholic fermentation.

Aging: 12 months in 50% French and 50% American oak barrels to obtain a full-bodied, structured and rounded wine.
